


8TH ANNIVERSARY

For Free Fall 2018, Make Studio presented Cordially Invited, a first-of-its-kind in Baltimore invitational exhibition and set of programming featuring artworks created in more than a dozen innovative U.S. and international studios that serve artists with disabilities. Through the month of October, Cordially Invited celebrated the exciting and thought-provoking art produced in progressive art studios with a central exhibition in Make Studio's

Showroom Gallery, a satellite of smaller "pop-up" art displays in partnering venues, and also an online gallery, allowing international programs from Scotland, Australia and Japan to participate.

For June's First Fridays in Hampden and 2018's

Artscape Gallery Network, Make Studio opened

"Viewfinding", featuring recent paintings and fabric

transfers by Hannah Leighton alongside complementary pieces

contributed by Make Studio artists. Gallery visitors were invited to

change their perspectives. and become active "viewers", as they were

able to interact with Leighton's "Viewfinders" -- colorful hula-hoop like

objects that invited them to creatively frame their vantage points on

artwork through. Aware of the power of visual language from a young
age, and found that, like many other dyslexic children, she struggled to
decipher the code that provides entry into the world of literacy. The
learning of language required perseverance and a willingness to
endure the confusion of entering a foreign land.

Flashing forward, she found the act of painting to tap her earliest experience with language and the challenges associated with it, and strives for freedom by tapping into the act of making in a non self-conscious way to achieve pure expression.

TERRAULT CONTEMPORARY




